

Step 4: Before uploading videos, explore the rest of the tabs for your channel, like modules and settings. You can select modules you wish to share with others on your channel. Under settings, you can create a name for your channel, change the type, make it visible or invisible to others, and tag your channel. Tag your channel with keywords related to your business, as it will make your site more searchable. Check out more settings on the video and playlists tabs as well.

Step 5: Once you have your video ready to be uploaded, you can click the "upload" button. Here, you can either upload a video, record, or drag a video file from your computer onto this page. Make sure to connect your YouTube to your Facebook and Twitter accounts to increase traffic to your channel.



Step 6: While your video is uploading, scroll down and edit the title and description of the video, pick a category for the video, and tag the video. Tags to individual movies are different than tags to your channel, and help others locate the specific video. If you only want specific people to see the video, you can change your privacy settings, as well.

When it has finished uploading, save changes to the settings, and click on the link provided to watch the video. **Step 7:** Click the "My Videos" button to edit your videos, and to check statistics on its viewership. You can also add notes throughout your videos with Annotations, and add extra audio. Explore the other advanced options if you wish.
